

# **THE SUPPLY CHAIN & RECOVERY**

The disruptions from COVID-19 evolved through 2020 with the deep recession followed by the beginnings of recovery for the economy. Steep challenges entering 2021 remain reflecting the widespread lingering nature of the pandemic. The shift of U.S. household consumption towards goods and away from services has continued, pressuring the essential workers across the supply chain. The initial availability of vaccines offers hope for improved conditions later in the year, yet the pandemic affects across all facets of the supply chain continue. With limited freight system capacity and constrained freight and factory workforce performance, supply chains remain under stress.
